Qualified participants may earn up to \$950. The AdventHealth Translational Research Institute is looking for patients who have been diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes to participate in a special research study, PHROG. This study will test if a specific research medication could increase the response to low blood glucose in people with type 1 diabetes. The response of the body to low blood sugar will be measured in healthy people as a reference point.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be between 20-60 years old
- Must be diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes for at least five years
- In general good health
- Use of insulin agents only (no oral anti-diabetics medications) for Type 1 diabetes treatment

YOUR COMMITMENT

- 3 months

STUDY PROCEDURES

- Medical history and medication review
- Vital signs
- Finger sticks and blood draws
- Taking study medication for 4 weeks
- Two overnight stays in the research unit
- Wear a blinded continuous glucose monitor for about 3 months
